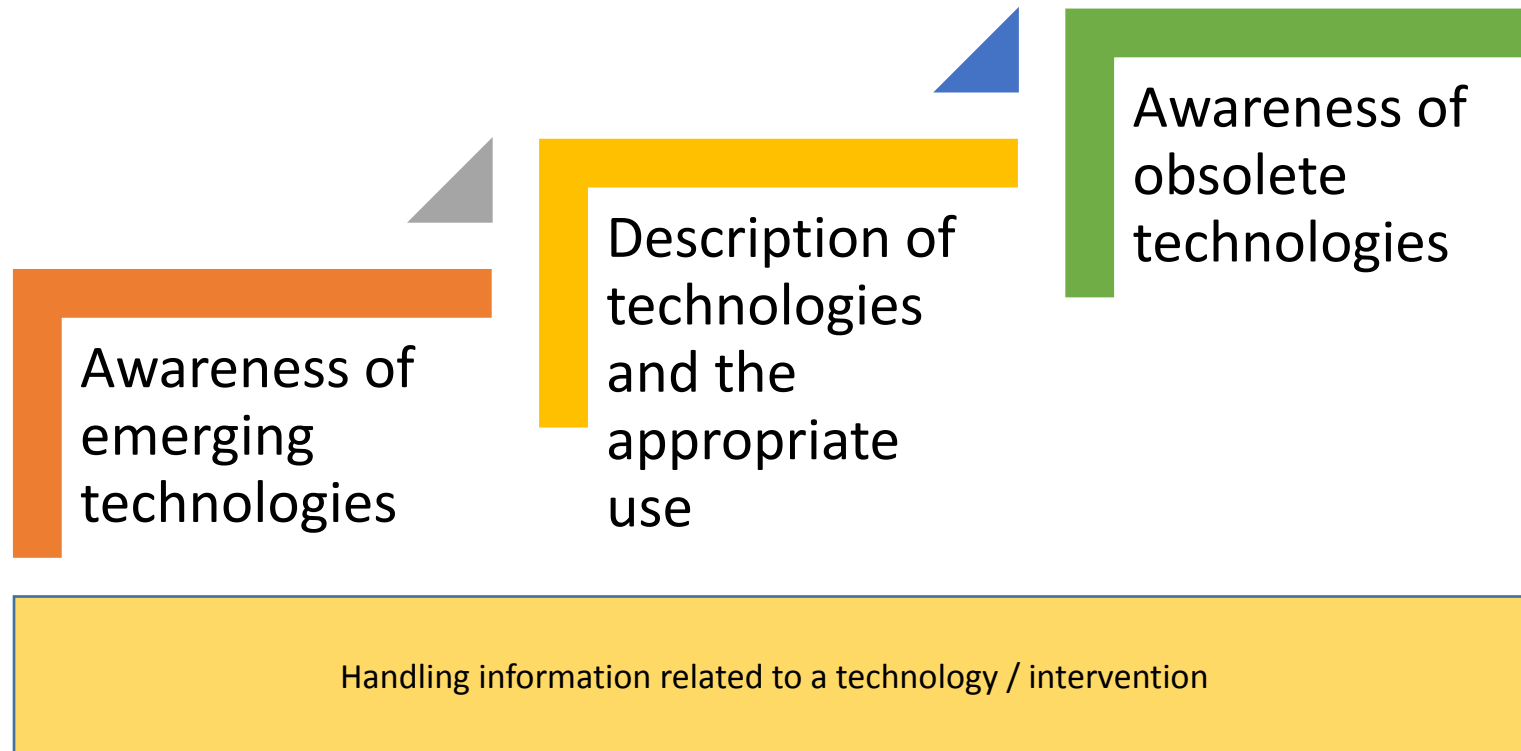

clear described tasks and supporting , requested services by members

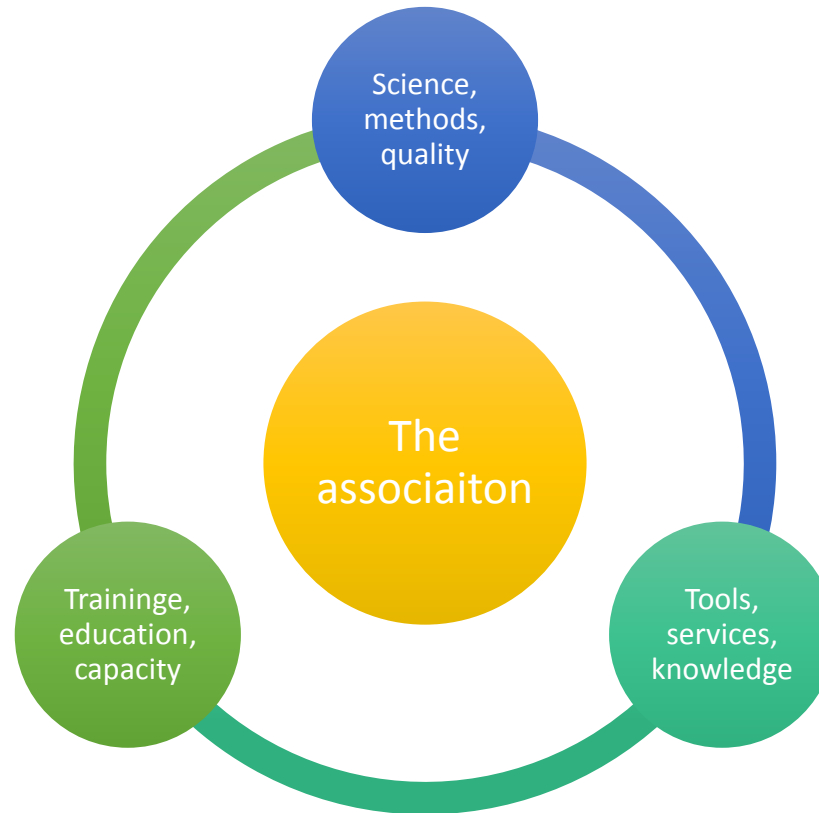
Seeking for supportive cooperation and effective workshare on all needed professional levels.

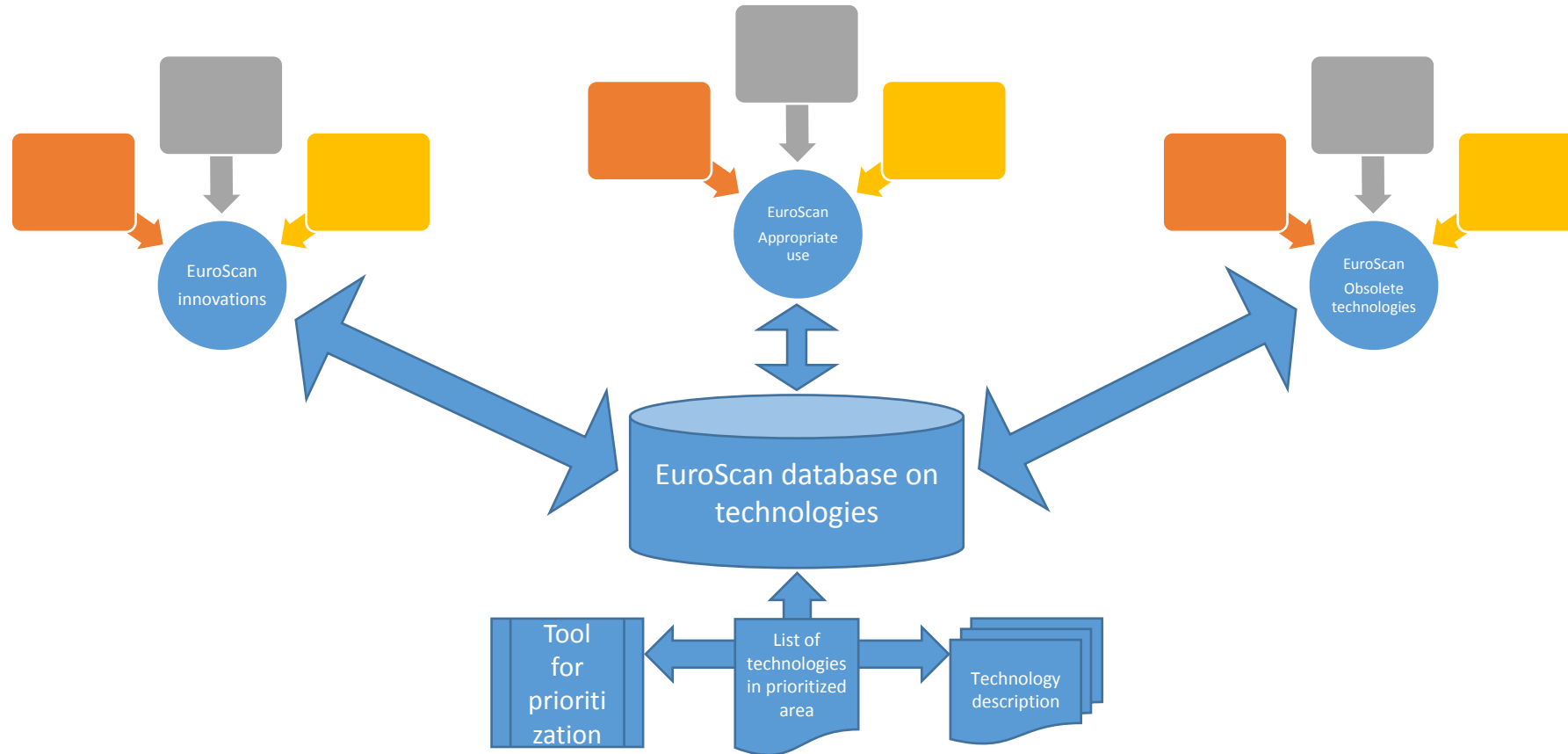


The axis of action

- The association is taking care of the areas of:

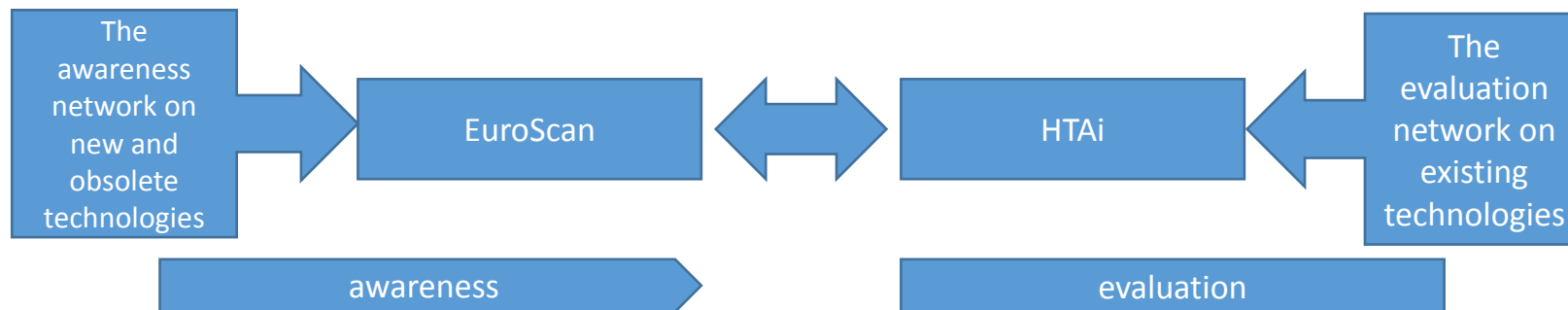


EuroScan tools within the lifecycle

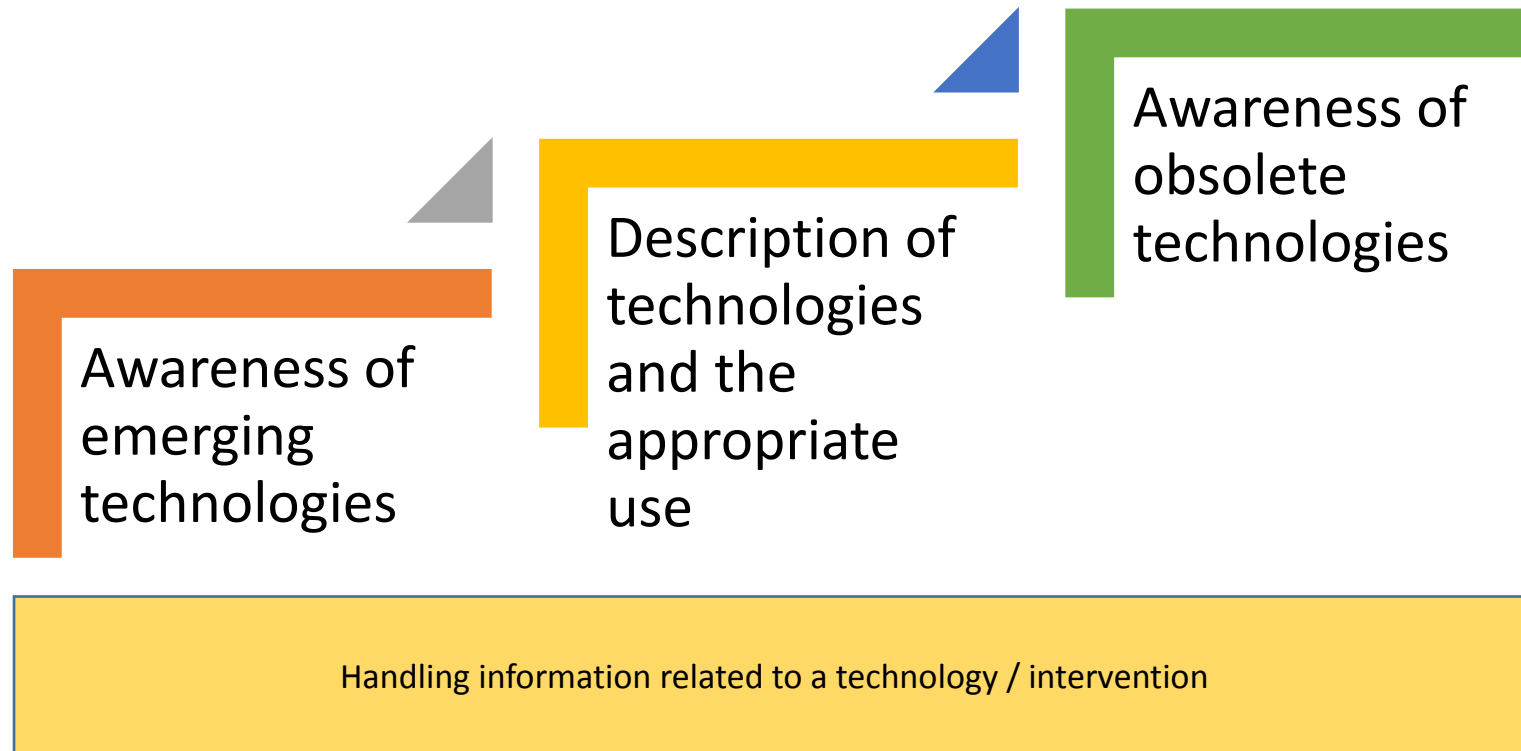
