### WHAT

In the first week of December 2019, Asc Academics will run their annual Health Economics of Public Health (HEPH) Winter School. The focus of this year's Winter School will be the Health Technology Assessment of preventive interventions, including the following main themes:

- Multi Criteria Decision Analysis (MCDA)
- Introduction to infectious diseases modelling
- Introduction to Fiscal modelling and Budget Optimization
- Pricing and reimbursement of preventive interventions

The Winter School will include an absorbing symposium about the future of public health, with (inter)national speakers on policy, trends, and science.
